

Landscape Oil Painting Class Outline

Location: Louisa Arts Center (212 Fredericksburg Ave, Louisa, VA 23093)

Dates: 4/6, 4/13, 4/27, 5/4, 5/11, 5/18 (*5/25 for students that need more time to finish their work)

Time: 10:00am – 12:00pm

Instructor: Les Camphuysen

- Class 1** Class introduction. Students will learn basic drawing techniques and will begin drawing their composition.
- Class 2** Students will learn about color value. They will mix a black paint using the 3 primary colors and complete painting a 9-value gray scale.
- Class 3** The class will learn how to use the gray scale to determine the value of their colors. They will learn color theory and how to mix colors using the 3 primary colors. The class will begin their painting. The instructor will coach the students as they work on their painting.
- Class 4** Students will continue work on their painting with demonstrations and assistance or coaching from the instructor.
- Class 5** Students continue work on their painting.
- Class 6** Students will finish their painting and the group will have an opportunity to assess one another's work.

Materials needed

- 1 – 37 ml tube of Titanium White paint
- 1 – 37 ml tube of Ultramarine blue
- 1 – 37 ml tube of Hansa yellow light
- 1 – 37 ml tube of Naphtol scarlet
- 1 – 4oz bottle of refined linseed oil
- 1 – 8oz bottle of Terpenoid natural paint thinner
- 1 – 8X10 or 9X12 cotton canvas board
- 1 - #2 bright bristle brush
- 1 - #4 right bristle brush
- 1 - #8 bright bristle brush
- 1 - baby food jar (for paint thinner)
- Pallet or mixing knife
- Paper pallet pad or pallet (9X12) or (12X16)
- 1 - #4H pencil and erase
- 1 – 12" ruler
